

Order of Blessings in service

MORNING BLESSINGS:

1) Vay'hi erev vay'hi boker yom hashishi vay'khulu hashamayim v'ha'aretz v'khol tz'va'am vay'khal elohim bayom hash'vi'i m'la'kh'to asher asah vayish'bot bayom hash'vi'i mikol m'la'kh'to asher asah Vay'varekh Elohim et yom hash'vi'i vay'kadeish oto ki vo shavat mikol m'la'kh'to asher bara Elohim la'asot

And there was evening and there was morning a sixth day
And the heavens and the earth were finished, and the whole host of them
And on the seventh day God ended His work that He had made
and He rested on the seventh day from all His work that He had made.
And God blessed the seventh day and sanctified it
because in it He had rested from all His work which God created and done

2) Barukh atah Adonai, Eloheinu, melekh ha-olam asher kid'shanu b'mitz'votav v'ratzah' vanu v'shabat kad'sho b'ahavah uv'ratzon hin'chilanu zikaron l'ma'aseih beresheet ki hu yom t'chilah, l'mik'ra'ei kodesh zeikher, l'yetzi'at Mitz'rayim ki vanu vachar'ta v'otanu kidash'ta mikol ha'amim v'shabat kad'sh'kha b'ahavah uv'ratzon hin'chal'tanu Barukh atah Adonai m'kadeish Hashabat Amen

Blessed are You, Lord our God, King of the Universe, who sanctifies us with his commandments and has been pleased with us You have lovingly and willingly given us Your holy Shabbat as an inheritance, in memory of creation because it is the first day of our holy assemblies, in memory of the exodus from Egypt because You have chosen us, and made us holy from all peoples, and have willingly and lovingly given us Your holy Shabbat for an inheritance

3) After the Ten commandments

Blessed are You, who sanctifies Shabbat

Ex.24:3.7

Amen

4) Shema

Sh'ma Israel Adonai Eloheinu Adonai echad (Hear, Israel, the Lord is our God, the Lord is One)

Baruch shem k'vod malchuto l'olam l'olam va'ed (Blessed be the Name of His glorious kingdom for ever and ever)

5) Hineh haTorah - Behold the Torah

Hine haTorah, asher sam Moshe Hine haTorah, d'var Adonai Yesh lanu Torah asher sam Moshe Yesh lanu Torah, d'var Adonai Hine haTorah, hine Yeshua Hine hu ba, d'var chaim Hine hu ba

Behold the Torah, which Moshe put forth Behold the Torah, the Word of God We have Torah, which Moshe put forth We have Torah, the Word of God Behold the torah, behold Yeshua Behold He's coming, the Word of Life Behold He's coming

6) V'Zot ha Torah (Behold the Torah)

Transliteration

V'zot haTorah asher sam Moshe lifnei b'nei Yisrael al pi Adonai b'yad Moshe **English:**

And this is the Torah that Moshe placed before the sons of Israel- by the command of Adonai, through the hand of Moshe.

7) **The Torah Blessing** (Before the reading)

R.Nathan: Barachu et Adonai ham'vorach.

(Bless Adonai who is blessed.)

Congregation: Barachu et Adonai ham'vorach l'olam va-ed.

(Blessed is Adonai who is blessed forever and ever.)

R.Nathan: Baruch atah, Adonai

Eloheinu, Melech haolam,

asher bachar banu mikol haamim,

v'natan lanu et Torato.

Baruch atah, Adonai, notein haTorah.

(Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has chosen us from among the peoples, and given us the Torah. Blessed are You, Adonai, who gives the Torah.)

8) **The Torah Blessing** (After the reading)

R.Nathan: Baruch atah, Adonai

Eloheinu, Melech haolam, asher natan lanu Torat emet, v'chayei olam nata b'tocheinu.

Baruch atah, Adonai, notein haTorah.

(Blessed are You, Adonai our God, Sovereign of the universe, who has given us a Torah of truth, implanting within us eternal life. Blessed are You, Adonai, who gives the Torah.)

9) Torah study

Baruch Ata Adonai Eloheinu Melech ha Olam, asher kidshanu bemitzvotav vetzivanu la'asok b'divrei Torah (Blessed are You Lord our God, King of the Universe, Who calls upon us to holiness through commanding us to engage in the study of Torah)
